COURSE DESCRIPTION

Following the Scope and Sequence outlined in World History and Cultures, this class will build upon what is taught in the World History class and add to the existing curriculum. The course will be set up as an addendum to the students required history class and provide additional information and opportunities for learning. The course is set up to be project-driven with research and writing pieces as required. This course is not designed to increase the student's work load, but to allow for creativity and exploration of the material presented in class.
